"If God be for **us** who can be against **us**? (Romans 8:31).

What a wonderful statement! But the question arises, who are those favoured people mentioned in our verse? Who exactly are the "US"?

The Epistle to the Romans shows that the "US" are people who, 'having been justified by faith have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.' (Romans 8:1).

Are you one of the "US"?

Furthermore, the "US" are those who were once God's enemies but now are reconciled to God by the death of His Son. (Romans 5:10).

Also, the "US" are the ones to whom the Spirit bears witness that they are the children of God. (Romans 8:16).

image of His Son." (Romans 8:30).
